His suggestion was getting a plan of action in place and have the contract for Withers Ravenel for preparing portable sewer treatment options ready by the regular town council meeting on Monday – October 14, 2024. The council discussed how portable plants operate and finding available units.



ADJOURNMENT


With no further business, the meeting was adjourned by motion of Wayne Peight.
